### **Medication Management Reviews- *The what, why, how, where and when.***

General Practitioners can refer patients for Medication Management Reviews (MMRs) to be performed by an accredited pharmacist. General Practice North has engaged General Practice Consultant Pharmacist and Educator, Danielle Truscott, to talk to GPs about MMRs at booked general practice visit education sessions.

The discussion about MMRs will include (but not restricted to):

- why having a patient's medications comprehensively reviewed can benefit you and your patient
- what is entailed in a medication management review performed by a pharmacist
- when to refer
- how to refer
- what to do with findings and suggestions

Danielle has undertaken over 1,500 MMRs over the last 20 years and has experience working with medical students and GPs in the educational setting over this time. Taking this opportunity to talk to Danielle might prompt you to incorporate this tool in the management of your patients and also help you manage your day-to-day workload through multidisciplinary collaboration and communication.
